

Tips that we want to give you...

You have to make some lists for the questions. For example, for the part of **Self introduction**, you can write the questions like, “Can you please introduce yourself?” or “Would you please introduce yourself?” ...and then, you have to think about, how you will answer the questions.

If you forget something important, or you forget some words, or you don't know how to express yourself, what will you do?
